Then, it’s on to the 54th Annual Opening Day presented by Wentworth, L&M Motors, and Heavy Hauler. On this special night, the big block Modifieds will kick off the season with a bang, as they battle for the CARQUEST\$3,000.00 to Win Modified Special.
